Water Tanks to Prevent Pollution of Water Sources

Water is one of the main needs for survival. Preventing water from being polluted is the responsibility of all parties including educational institutions. Universitas Sriwijaya (UNSRI) is one of the educational institutions in South Sumatra that has built several water tanks used in the campus environment. This is done to prevent contamination or pollution of water sources. The water tanks are made of concrete, some of which are built on the ground. Proper channels are also built around the tanks to prevent liquid waste from flowing into the tanks. In addition to building water reservoirs, UNSRI also provides storage using commercial water tanks to prevent pollution of the water. The tanks are periodically checked to ensure that they are still functioning properly. The water quality testing process is also carried out periodically.
