Drought-tolerant Plants as a Way to Keeping the Campus Green

Water is the main source of life, including plants. In supporting the growth and development of plants, adequate water is needed for the plants. Some plants require a lot of water, but there are also plants that are tolerant of little water or require little water (drought tolerant plants). Some of these plants have been planted at Sriwijaya University (UNSRI), for example *Philodendron selloum* is one of the plants classified as drought tolerant. *Sansevieria pearsonii* and *Hippeastrum papilio* are also drought-tolerant plants.
