
SDG 17 - Indicator 17.2.4. Collaboration for SDG best practice

As described in the Metric 17.2.1 above that *Universitas Sriwijaya* have participated in the UI-GreenMetric since 2021. Since then, *Universitas Sriwijaya* have shown progress in its commitment to maintaining the ecological conditions of the campus.

In 2023, the UI GreenMetric ranking of universities in Indonesia placed *Universitas Sriwijaya* at 19th out of 145 universities in the country (https://greenmetric.ui.ac.id/rankings/ranking-by-country-2023/Indonesia) and at 136 out of 1,182 universities all over the world participating in the UI GreenMetric World University Ranking (https://greenmetric.ui.ac.id/rankings/overall-rankings-2023). This ranking evaluates universities based on their commitment and performance in sustainability and green initiatives. This position reflects the efforts to promote environmental responsibility and sustainability within its campus and academic programs.
