AIESEC is an international youth organization present in more than 126 countries, one of which is Indonesia. In Indonesia itself, AIESEC has been established for more than 30 years and has spread to 26 universities. The purpose of this agreement is to organize Professional Architect Education (PPAr) in accordance with the curriculum and educational materials that are in accordance with the KKNI Higher Education (Dikti) standards and competency achievements that have been set by the International Union of Architects (UIA) and the Indonesian Architects Association (IAI). In their capacity as
